

The YMCA of Hannibal is providing emergency care for the children of essential medical professionals, first responders, and essential workers in the community.

The program will utilize the Y's standard child care curriculum and provide active spaces. Since the Y's facility is closed to the public, it enables usage of multiple facility areas to allow for **physical distancing** between students and their classmates.

To limit the potential spread of COVID-19, public health regulations limit the YMCA to a maximum of 80 children based on approved usable space. Children will be placed in appropriate classes of no more than 8 students per room with 2 attendants. Childcare will be available for K-5th grade and the program will run for those registrants from 7:00am-5:30pm Monday-Friday.

The service cost will be kept at a minimum of \$15 for members and \$25 for guests with breakfast, lunch and snack provided. Please inquire about scholarship opportunities.

While our YMCA has been closed to protect public health, the custodial team has worked tirelessly at **cleaning and sanitizing** all areas of each facility. Staff members are also cleaning the child care areas before children arrive for the day, throughout the day and at the close of the program.

The YMCA of Hannibal is providing a **free** curbside pickup Grab and Go food service. Our Grab and Go will be available from 2:30pm-3:30pm Monday-Friday. We are encouraging community members to drive up to the front of the building, and one of our YMCA staff will deliver the meals to their vehicle.
