- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 3.3% in Marion County, MO from 15,157 to 14,659. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 6.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.8% to 62.5% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.2% of Marion County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.7% below the national average), and **9.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






Unemployment Rate Trends

Marion County, MO had a November 2020 unemployment rate of 2.95%, decreasing from 4.46% 5 years before.





Marion County, MO has 2,251 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1.626.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Marion County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 8,388 people 55 or older, while there are 9,112 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Marion County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 11,380 racially diverse people, while there are 2,844 here.




Property Crime













Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings








