

#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 1.7**% since 2015, growing by 170. Population is expected to **increase by 1.1**% between 2020 and 2025, adding 117.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs remained constant in Ralls County, MO at 3,950. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 3.6%. The labor force participation rate decreased from 68.4% to 65.4% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.1% of Ralls County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (11.8% below the national average), and **7.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Animal Slaughtering and Processing, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Gasoline Stations.



As of 2020 the region's population increased by 1.7% since 2015, growing by 170. Population is expected to increase by 1.1% between 2020 and 2025, adding 117.




### **Unemployment Rate Trends**


#### **Millennials**

Ralls County, MO has 1,604 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 2,126.






Ralls County, MO has 879 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 583.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Ralls County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 3,031 people 55 or older, while there are 3,915 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Ralls County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 4,112 racially diverse people, while there are 495 here.




#### **Property Crime**




### **Top Industry LQ**












#### **Top Occupation Earnings**




